Phillip Avenell named as a clockmaker in Farnham in a geneoloy index - no date Philip AVENELL of Farnham was the maker of most of the Clocks in Puttenham (4 miles east of Farnham). The dials are of Brass - the hour circle of a white metal - the cherubic decoration at the corners of cast brass. Numerals Roman, hour hand only. BROWN is now 64 years old - His clock (one of P. AVENELL'S make) belonged to his Grandfather - Philip AVENELL therefore must have made clocks as early as the year 1750 - A 1800.
